



Comparison of These 2 Useful Approaches


Information Dissemination

- Addresses the need of the disseminator, not necessarily the need of the audience
- The interest of the data to the audience may not have validated
- May resolve inaccurate information
- May motivate HCP to learn more about the subject (pre-condition in educational design speak)

Continuing Education

- Translation of information in a way that is relevant to the context of the audience
- Designed to validate and/or change behavior to best clinical practice
- Includes discussion/training related to skills and strategies for use by HCP/team that address resolution of practice gap
- Assesses learning and change outcomes (subjectively or objectively)
